Ten years ago, at Marsworth Village Hall, Phoenix Theatre Company and I co-promoted a production of Marreau and the Chocolate Policeman. We had a lot of fun performing it and so I decided to write a sequel. Meanwhile the east of Marreau were keen to perform some "Course Acting" plays. In order to enable us to do the sort of plays that we wished to without imposing upon Phoenix we decided to form our own theatre company. That is how Frayed Knot was born. Ten years later we're still going strong.

A glance down the list of our past productions will show that this is our 22<sup>nd</sup> outing - if you include that original Marreau - with a total of 25 plays performed.

There have been high points and low points. Some plays have been quite experimental, some have been old favourites. The vast majority have been comedies of one sort or another, though there have been exceptions with melodramas, ghost stories and even a tragedy. We have had something like fifty different people act with us - and probably the same number again have helped in one way or another with production.

We believe we offer a warm welcome to anyone who is interested in performing with us - or helping in any other way with productions. This show alone includes three new faces that have never acted with us before.

I would like to express my thanks to Matthew Homes Limited for sponsoring us again this year, and to our other advertisers for their contributions which help us to survive as a theatre company at a time of ever-increasing costs.

### Requiem for Marreau

The period is early 1930s.

#### Marreau - The story so far

Hemlock Montrachet Boniface Etienne Marreau's first appearance was in Marreau and the Chocolate Policeman where we found him investigating the murder of Lady Eustace and subsequently of her son, Edward who was married to Isabel ... the same Isabel that features prominently in this play.

Marreau is usually ably assisted in his cases by his secretary Gwendolyn and helped or hindered by his affable, noble but rather dim friend Simpson. The second adventure found them attempting to recover some fantastically valuable stolen jewellery in Marreau and The African Moon - a case which quickly became far more serious with a succession of murders, including that of the fearsomely unpleasant Raging Ranulph.

Marreau never seems quite sure whether he is French or Belgian ... or indeed from Monaco, Switzerland or Luxembourg ... or any other francophone country for that matter - often changing his mind several times during a play. He considers himself the greatest detective who has ever lived, he is, however probably sadly deluded. In the fourth adventure, Marreau and the Bloody Carpet, we met his arch enemy, Professor Maurice Hearty. This evil genius not only caused problems for Marreau but was also responsible for the murder of Gwendolyn's husband, New Mexico Smith - known as Mexi - who was suffocated with a newt during the investigation of The Sword of Carthage, the fifth adventure. Gwendolyn had met him originally during the mysterious murders of the third play - centred on an ancient Egyptian mummy in Curse of Cardiff.

By the sixth adventure, Clouds of Death, Hearty's malign influence had become intolerable and in a dramatic final scene first Hearty claims that Marreau is actually English and then that he himself is Marreau's half-brother. In the ensuing tussle Hearty plummets down the "bottomless" well in Wildboar Castle. Tragically however at the very moment of his victory over his bête noir, Marreau stumbles and follows him down into the unfathomed depths - never to be seen again!

Two other characters regularly crop up in nearly all the Marreaus. Doctor Protheroe, who was having an affair with - and has since married - Edward's sister Jane in the original play. The other is Farmer, a bumbling rustic policeman who gained swift promotion on the back of Marreau's successes until one fateful day when he arrested the Prince of Wales and was demoted from Chief Constable to just Constable.

So, at the beginning of this play we find the two surviving members of the famous trio pondering life without their friend .... Until a letter arrives ....
